- Identify resources available to assist male survivors & their supporters including SAMSN services.

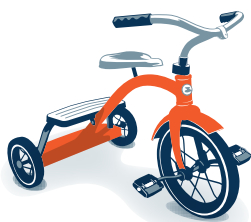
